This conference is an opportunity to help break down some of these barriers and come together to share capacity and resources and work together.

This conference offers participants a comprehensive look at innovative strategies, tools, and supports to address housing and homelessness. Sessions will explore legal and funding supports, project development from pre-planning to construction, community housing models, and the importance of data systems like HIFIS, By-Name Lists, and Coordinated Access. Attendees will also gain practical insights into municipal capacity building, Income Support updates and discussions, Reaching Home application guidance, and the power of partnerships to drive sustainable, community-based housing solutions and more... we have great presentations, discussions and materials to share!

Presenters include representatives from CAEH, Raising the Roof, MNL, PLIANL, our Community Advisory Boards, the Provincial Government and Health System, along with various community partners who all share a common interest in addressing housing instability and homelessness issues in our rural and remote communities.

In addition to concurrent information sessions, we will have panels where we will hear about current system challenges, through the lenses of lived experience and frontline support, and make recommendations for change. We will engage in discussions around innovative collaborations that foster new ideas and efforts to support those changes. Our conference will end with setting goals and developing plans on how we can move forward as one collective voice for change!

Along with guest speakers and planned networking opportunities, there will be lots to learn, lots to share, and lots of time to connect with everyone.
